

## POTTERS WEEKEND IN NEW PLYMOUTH & HASTINGS; SCOTTISH SINGLES IN WELLINGTON

The New Zealand PBA programme continues this weekend with 'Potter's Weekend' in New Plymouth and Hastings as players compete to represent New Zealand at the World Indoor Singles or Pairs at Potter's Leisure Resort in Norfolk, England in January. And PBA qualifiers begin in Wellington with a Ranking singles tournament and a qualifier for the Scottish Singles.

The World Indoor Pairs qualifiers this year will revert to 2-bowl pairs as the World Bowls Tour moved back to 2-bowl rather than 3 bowls per player while New Zealand was absent during the Pandemic.

Early feature matches include former national Finals Weekend players Kristin Stampa against Bruce Mummery in the World Indoor Singles on Saturday, and PBA debutante Dean Elgar paired with Aidan Zittersteijn facing John Cottam and Ian Andrews in the World Indoor Pairs qualifiers in New Plymouth; Gavin Keighley will be trying at his fifth attempt to beat former number one Murray Glassey in the World Indoor Singles on Saturday, and partnered with Mike Le Geyt, also faces a tough first hurdle on Sunday against 2020 World Indoor Pairs NZ reps Mike Isaacson and Tony Terry in Hastings; and Wellington will see the return of chairman Richard Corry whose last PBA outing was representing Canada against 2022 top 40 player Kennie Critchlow on Sunday in the Scottish Singles qualifier.
